



Topics for Follow-up Raised by Rochelle Heights Association

- Update the resource and reference materials to reflect updated standards and topics. E.g., solar panels, windows, etc.
- Address gaps in board member training to provide a standards based approach to providing decisions and clarify board member roles/required experience
- Define and implement approaches to ensure consistency of decisions.

Historic Preservation Action Plan

- Develop design guidelines
- Revise local code in conformance with Certified Local
 Government model code
- Increase awareness of link between historic preservation and economic development
- Develop educational outreach about local historic preservation practices
- Update website to include funding opportunities
- Seek funding opportunities. Leverage CLG status.
 - Historic Preservation Fund
 - Main Street Program
- Offer fee waivers

City Actions - Next Steps Implement Certified Local Government Model Code Amendments

- Codify training and attendance requirements
- Expedite certain in-kind, maintenance, repair work without a public hearing
- Update certificate of appropriateness criteria
- Require public notice signage to be posted on property with hearing dates updated
- Codify CoA extension provisions
- Add definitions
- Present to Council (October) and conduct public hearing (November)

City Actions - Next Steps Historical and Landmarks Review Board

- SHPO board training October
- Create periodic RHA leadership meetings with HLRB leadership
- Add alternate members to mitigate quorum issues
- Provide accessible, user-friendly guide to application process
- ID materials to assist HLRB with review to avoiding delays
- Eliminate fee for hearing notice list Eliminated September

City Actions – Next Steps Bolster Website Content & Provide Useful Resources

- Create brief, accessible documents for pressing issues currently including:
 - Solar panels
 - Windows
 - Siding
- ID funding opportunities Leverage CLG status.
 - Historic Preservation Fund
 - Main Street Program
- Add Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties – September
- Add Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation & Illustrated Guidelines on Sustainability for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings - September
